Bromhexine Hydrochloride (8mg)

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What REXOM $_{\text{TM}}$ Bromhexine is used for

For treatment of conditions of the respiratory tract associated with retention of mucus secretions such as inflammation of the airway and asthma, as an aid to expel mucous.

How REXOM_{TM} Bromhexine works

REXOM_{TM} Bromhexine helps to clear the chest by thinning the mucus in your air passages.

-When you must not use it

It should not be used if you have known to be hypersensitive to Bromhexine or other components of the formulation.

-Before you start to use it

Should be used with care in people with gastric ulceration.

Pregnancy and lactation

Talk to you doctor before taking this medicine if you are pregnant, might become pregnant or are breastfeeding.

-Taking other medicines

Inform your doctor or pharmacist before taking this medicines, including any that you get without a prescription from your pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

How to use REXOM_{TM} Bromhexine

-How much to use

Always use $REXOM_{TM}$ Bromhexine exactly as your doctor has prescribed. You should check with your doctor or pharmacist if in doubt.

The usual dose:

Adult: 8-16mg

Children 6-12 years: 4mg

-When to use it

To be used 3 times daily. Use as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

-How long to use it

Continue taking REXOM_{TM} Bromhexine as your doctor recommended. If symptoms persist, consult your doctor.

-If you forget to use it

Consult your doctor or pharmacist on what you should do if you forget to use it.

Take the missed dose as soon as you remember. If it is almost time for your next dose, wait until then to take the medicine and skip the missed dose. Do not take a double dose to make up for the missed dose.

-If you use too much (overdose)

Contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital, if you think you or anyone else may have taken too much of this medicine. Do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning. You may need urgent medical attention.

While you are using $REXOM_{TM}$ Bromhexine

-Things you must do

- Tell all the doctors, dentists and pharmacists treating you that you are taking REXOM_{TM} Bromhexine.
- Tell your doctor immediately if you become pregnant while taking this medication.

-Things you must not do

- Do not take more than the recommended dose unless your pharmacist or doctor tells you.
- Do not take any new medicines without consulting your doctor or pharmacist.

• Do not give REXOM_{TM} Bromhexine to anyone else, even if they have the same symptoms or condition as you.

-Things to be careful of

Be careful driving or operating machinery until you know how REXOM $_{TM}$ Bromhexine affects you.

Side effects

If side effects persist, do not take the medicine and refer to the doctor.

Tell your doctor if you notice any of the following side effects or notice any other effects not listed:

- Gastrointestinal
- Transient rise in blood test aminotransferase

Storage and disposal of REXOM $_{\text{TM}}$ Bromhexine

-Storage

Keep container tightly closed. Store between 15-30°C. Protect from light. Keep medicine out of reach of children.

-Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
