

REXOMTM WINA NEURO TABLET

Pyridoxine Hydrochloride (B6)/Thiamine Hydrochloride (B1)/Cyanocobalamin (B12) (200mg/100mg/200mcg)

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What REXOMTM Wina Neuro is used for

For disorder that affects peripheral nerve, nerve pain, nerve disorders caused by diabetes or by certain medications, shoulder and arm syndrome (painful disability), deficiency and raised requirements of vitamin B1, B6 and B12.

How REXOMTM Wina Neuro works

REXOMTM Wina Neuro contains 3 types of Vitamin B which are Pyridoxine Hydrochloride (B6), Cyanocobalamin (B12) and Thiamine Hydrochloride (B1). These are the vitamin B which will replenish the deficiency in the body.

Before you use REXOMTM Wina Neuro

-When you must not use it

It should not be given to:

- people known to be hypersensitive to any of the components of the formulation.
- people suffering from psoriasis (skin disorder).
- people with gastro-intestinal problem.

-Before you start to use it

Pregnancy and lactation

Talk to your doctor before taking this medicine if you are pregnant, might become pregnant or are breastfeeding.

-Taking other medicines

Inform your doctor or pharmacist before taking this medicines, including any that you get without a prescription from your

pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

How to use REXOMTM Wina Neuro

-How much to use

Always use REXOMTM Wina Neuro exactly as your doctor has prescribed. You should check with your doctor or pharmacist if in doubt.

The usual dose:

Adults: 1- 3 tablets daily, or as directed by physician.

The tablets are swallowed unchewed with a little liquid, with or after meal.

-When to use it

Use as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

-How long to use it

Continue taking REXOMTM Wina Neuro as your doctor recommended. If symptoms persist, consult your doctor.

-If you forget to use it

Consult your doctor or pharmacist on what you should do if you forget to use it.

Take the missed dose as soon as you remember. If it is almost time for your next dose, wait until then to take the medicine and skip the missed dose. Do not take a double dose to make up for the missed dose.

-If you use too much (overdose)

Contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital, if you think you or anyone else may have taken too much of this medicine. Do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning. You may need urgent medical attention.

Taking too much REXOMTM Wina Neuro may cause:

- severe peripheral nerve pain.
- allergic hypersensitive reactions.

While you are using REXOMTM Wina Neuro

-Things you must do

- Tell all the doctors, dentists and pharmacists treating you that you are taking REXOMTM Wina Neuro.

- Tell your doctor immediately if you become pregnant while taking this medication.

-Things you must not do

- Do not take more than the recommended dose unless your pharmacist or doctor tells you.
- Do not take any new medicines without consulting your doctor or pharmacist.
- Do not give REXOMTM Wina Neuro to anyone else, even if they have the same symptoms or condition as you.

-Things to be careful of

Be careful driving or operating machinery until you know how REXOMTM Wina Neuro affects you.

Side effects

Like all medicines, REXOMTM Wina Neuro can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them.

If side effects persist, do not take the medicine and refer to the doctor.

Tell your doctor if you notice any of the following side effects or notice any other side effects:

- Hypersensitivity reactions are rare and observed mainly on the skin.
- Vitamin B6 can aggravate existing acne.

Storage and disposal of REXOMTM Wina Neuro

-Storage

Keep container tightly closed. Store between 15- 30°C. Protect from light.

Keep medicine out of reach of children.

-Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.

starch, Microcrystalline cellulose,
Kollidon PVP and Spirit chloroform.
