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What Prime Nutmeg Medicated Ointment is used for

It is used to temporary relief of minor aches and pains associated with muscular pains, sprains and cramps.

How Prime Nutmeg Medicated Ointment works

Prime Nutmeg Medicated Ointment contains nutmeg oil which is a mild rubefacient. It also contains menthol which causes a sensation of coldness followed by an pain relieving effect.

Before you use Prime Nutmeg Medicated Ointment

- When you must not use it
- allergic to the ingredients of the product.
- Before you start to use it

Stop application if skin irritation occurs. Risk benefits should be considered for pregnant or breastfeeding mothers. Safety for use in pregnancy and lactation has not been established.

Not recommended for infants below 2 years. Caution must be exercised when older children are treated.

- Taking other medicines

The medicine is for topical application, usually will have minimal effect on other medications.

However, please inform the doctor or pharmacist if taking other medicines.

How to use Prime Nutmeg Medicated Ointment

- <u>How much to use</u> Apply to affected part.
- When to use it
 Apply three times daily.
- <u>How long to use it</u>

You should check with your doctor or pharmacist.

- If you forget to use it

If forget to use this medicine, use it as soon as remember. Then next, use this medicine at the usual time.

- <u>If you use too much (overdose)</u>
If used too much *Prime Nutmeg*Medicated Ointment, contact your doctor, an emergency department or a poison center immediately.

While you are using *Prime Nutmeg Medicated Ointment*

Things you must do
 Inform doctor of medications that you are taking.

- Things you must not do

Do not stop using medication although feeling better after a few days, until the prescribed course is finished. It is dangerous to place any camphor containing product into the nostrils of children. A small amount applied this way may cause immediate collapse.

- Things to be careful of

If pregnant or become pregnant or breastfeeding during treatment, should not use *Prime Nutmeg Medicated Ointment* unless doctor advised.

Side effects

Menthol may give rise to allergic reactions, including hives, flushing and headache. If any of the side effects become serious or any other side effects not listed in this leaflet, please inform the doctor or pharmacist.
