

CLOMAZOL CREAM

Clotrimazole (1% w/w)

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What Clomazol is used for

It is used to treat fungal infections such as ringworm, athlete's foot, fungal nappy rash, candidiasis (oral or vaginal thrush) and fungal sweat rash.

How Clomazol works

It contains clotrimazole which is an antifungal agent which fights the cause of fungal infections.

Before you use Clomazol

- When you must not use it

- allergic to clotrimazole or other ingredients of Clomazol.

- Before you start to use it

Do not apply occlusive dressing over this medication unless directed by doctor. Safety for use in pregnancy and lactation has not been established. Inform the doctor if pregnant or lactating.

- Taking other medicines

The medicine is for topical application, usually will have minimal effect on other medications. However, please inform the doctor or pharmacist if taking other medicines.

How to use Clomazol

- How much to use

Apply thinly to affected skin 2 – 3 times daily and continue for 1 – 2 weeks after infection have healed.

- When to use it

Please follow the advice of the doctor or pharmacist.

- How long to use it

You should check with your doctor or pharmacist.

- If you forget to use it

If forget to use this medicine, use it as soon as remember. Then next, use this medicine at the usual time.

- If you use too much (overdose)

If used too much Clomazol, contact your doctor, an emergency department or a poisoning center immediately.

While you are using Clomazol

- Things you must do

Inform doctor of medications taking.

- Things you must not do

Do not stop using medication although feeling better after a few days, until the prescribed course is finished.

- Things to be careful of

If pregnant or become pregnant or breast-feeding during treatment, should not use Clomazol unless doctor advised.

Side effects

Skin rash or hives, blistering, burning, itching, peeling, redness, stinging, swelling or skin irritation may occur occasionally. If any of the side effects become serious or any other side effects not listed in this leaflet, please inform the doctor or pharmacist.

Storage and Disposal of Clomazol

- Storage

Store in cool, dry place below 30°C. Protect from light. Keep out of reach of children.

- Disposal

Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required.
