What REXOM_{TM} Wina B Complex is used for

For the prevention and treatment of vitamin **B**-complex deficiency symptoms.

How REXOM_{TM} Wina B Complex works

REXOM_{TM} Wina B Complex contains 6 types of Vitamin B which are Cyanocobalamin (B12), Riboflavin (B2), Thiamine Hydrochloride (B1), Calcium Pantothenate (B5), Nicotinamide (B3) and Pridoxine Hydrochloride (B6). These are the vitamin B which will replenish the deficiency in the body.

Before you use REXOM_{TM} Wina B Complex

-When you must not use it

It should not be used in people known to be hypersensitive to any of the components of the formulation.

-Before you start to use it

Pregnancy and lactation

Talk to you doctor before taking this medicine if you are pregnant, might become pregnant or are breastfeeding.

-Taking other medicines

Inform your doctor or pharmacist before taking this medicines, including any that you get without a prescription from your pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

Complex

-How much to use

Always use REXOM_{TM} Wina B Complex exactly as your doctor has prescribed. You should check with your doctor or pharmacist if in doubt.

The usual dose:

Adult: 2-4 tablets daily. Children: 1-2 tablets daily.

-When to use it

Use as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

-How long to use it

Continue taking REXOM_{TM} Wina B Complex as your doctor recommended. If symptoms persist, consult your doctor.

-If you forget to use it

Consult your doctor or pharmacist on what you should do if you forget to use

Take the missed dose as soon as you remember. If it is almost time for your next dose, wait until then to take the medicine and skip the missed dose. Do not take a double dose to make up for the missed dose.

-If you use too much (overdose)

Contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital, if you think you or anyone else may have taken too much of this medicine. Do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning. You may need urgent medical attention.

While you are using REXOM_{TM} Wina **B** Complex

-Things you must do

- Tell all the doctors, dentists and pharmacists treating you that you are taking REXOM_{TM} Wina B Complex.
- Tell your doctor immediately if you become pregnant while taking this medication.

-Things you must not do

take Do not more than the your recommended dose unless pharmacist or doctor tells you.

- How to use REXOM_{TM} Wina B Do not take any new medicines without consulting your doctor or pharmacist.
 - Do not give REXOM_{TM} Wina B Complex to anyone else, even if they have the same symptoms or condition as you.

-Things to be careful of

Be careful driving or operating machinery until you know how REXOM_{TM} Wina B Complex affects

Side effects

REXOM_{TM} Wina B Complex seldom cause toxicity in person with normal kidney function. If side effects persist, do not take the medicine and refer to the doctor.

Storage and disposal of REXOM $_{\text{TM}}$ Wina B Complex

-Storage

Store below 30°C. Keep container tightly closed. Protect from heat and light. Keep medicine out of reach of children.

-Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via waste water or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
