## What QV Flare Up Bath Oil is used for

- Emollient adjunctive treatment of recurrent eczema (inflammation of the outer layer of the skin) in which secondary *staphylococcus aureus* infection is a problem
- QV Flare Up Bath Oil relieves atopic eczema (inflammation of the outer layer of the skin)

## How QV Flare Up Bath Oil works

- Dual action formula reduces the level of bacteria and helps prevent moisture loss.
- Calms irritated skin and reduces roughness and scaling.
- Leave a thin film of occlusive oil on the skin, which helps to rehydrate skin.

## Before you use QV Flare Up Bath Oil

### - When you must not use it

This product should not be used by individuals with known sensitivity to any ingredients of this product. Not recommended for infants under 6 months.

### - Before you start to use it

Please discuss with your doctor or pharmacist before using the product.

### - Taking other medicines

Currently there have been no reports of problems when this product is used with other medicines.

## How to use Pinetarsol Bath Oil

### - How much to use

1. Fill bath with water. There should be at least enough water in the bath to submerge the QV Flare Up bath Oil bottle to the marked 'fill line.'

2. Add QV Flare Up Bath Oil to the bath a drop at a time, stirring the water gently by hand to ensure the product is distributed evenly throughout. The water will start to become cloudy.

3. There are two panels on the back of the QV Flare Up Bath Oil bottle, one black, and one grey.

Submerge the bottle in the bath until the fill line on the bottle and the water level in the bath meet.

4. There is enough QV Flare Up Bath Oil in the bath when the grey panel blends with the cloudiness of the water and is no longer visible. You should still be able to see the black panel.

5. If both panels are still visible, repeat steps 2 through 3 until only the black panel is visible.

*Note that the panels will not change colour in any way, and will still be present when the pack is removed from water.*

6. If neither panel is visible, there is too much QV Flare Up Bath Oil in the water. Add more water to the bath and repeat steps 2 through 3 until only the black panel is visible.

### - When to use it

Soak in the bath daily for 10-15 minutes. Gently pat skin dry.

### - How long to use it

Please follow the advice of the doctor or pharmacist.

### - If you forget to use it

If forget to use this medicine, use it as soon as remember. Then next, use this medicine at the usual time.

### - If you use too much (overdose)

No information is available concerning overdosage in human beings following topical application.

## While you are using it

### - Things you must do

Avoid contact with eyes. For external use only.

### - Things you must not do

Do not use undiluted or inadequately diluted. Do not swallow. Do not use with soap or detergent as these may reduce the activity of benzalkonium chloride.

### - Things to be careful of

If product enters eyes, rinse thoroughly with clean water. If irritation occurs, discontinue use.

## Side effects

Allergy to any ingredient may cause skin irritation.

## Storage and Disposal of QV Flare Up Bath Oil

### - Storage

Store below 30°C. Keep out of reach of children.

### - Disposal

QV Flare Up Bath Oil should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of QV Flare Up Bath Oil that is no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
