Before you use Winmyco Antiseptic Cream

- When you must not use it
Do not use if you are hypersensitivity
to Acriflavine HCI or any other
ingredients in this product.

- Before you start to use it For external use only. Avoid contact

with eyes, nose and mouth. Not to be taken.

- Taking other medicines

- How much to use

Apply to the affected area 2 to 3 times a day as needed.

- When to use it
