Dequalinium Chloride (250 mcg)

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What Dequa 250mcg Lozenges is used for

Indicated for the minor infections of the mouth and throat.

How Dequa 250mcg Lozenges works

Dequalinium Chloride kills the bacteria and inhibit the fungal growth.

Before you use Dequa 250mcg Lozenges

- When you must not use it
Pregnancy and lactation

No reports regarding adverse effects.

Ask your doctor or pharmacists for advice before taking Dequa 250mcg Lozenges.

- Before you start to use it

Tell your doctor if you are hypersensitive to the Dequalinium or other ingredients in this product.

- Taking other medicines

Tell your doctor if you are taking any other medicines, including any that you buy without a prescription from a pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

How to use Dequa 250mcg Lozenges

- How much to use

A dose of 1 lozenge is used 6 times a day.

Dissolve slowly in the mouth without chewing. The dose should be adjusted in consideration of the severity of the symptoms.

The directions given may differ from the information contained in this leaflet. If you do not understand the instructions on the label, ask your doctor or pharmacist for help.

- When to use it

Use as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

- How long to use it

Continue taking Dequa 250mcg Lozenges for as long as your doctor recommends.

- If you forget to use it

Take the missed dose as soon as you remember. If it almost time for your next dose, wait until then to take the medicine and skip the missed dose. Do not take a double dose to make up for the missed dose.

- If you use too much (overdose)

No reports regarding overdose.

Contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital, if you think you or anyone else may have taken too much of this medicine. Do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning. You may need urgent medical attention.

While you are using it

- Things you must do

Take your medicine exactly as your doctor has told you.

Tell the doctor, dentist and pharmacist treating you that you are taking Dequa 250mcg Lozenges.

- Things you must not do

Do not take any new medicines without consulting your doctor or pharmacist.

Do not give Dequa 250mcg Lozenges to anyone else, even if they have the same symptoms or condition as you.

Side effects

Side effects of the Dequa 250mcg Lozenges and undesirable accompanying symptoms have not been observed.

Visit your doctor or pharmacist immediately if you experience any side

effects after taking this medicine. You may report any side effects or adverse drug reactions directly to the National Centre for Adverse Drug Reaction Monitoring by calling Tel: 03-78835550, or visiting the website npra.moh.gov.my (Public → Reporting Side Effects to Medicines (ConSERF) or Vaccines (AEFI)).

Storage and Disposal of Dequa 250mcg Lozenges

- Storage

Keep out of reach of children
Protect from light
Store in dry place below 30°C
Keep the container tightly closed

- Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
