What Fuji Vitamin C is used for

For the treatment of of scurvy and other forms of Vitamin C deficiency.

How Fuji Vitamin C works

Fuji Vitamin C contains ascorbic acid and sodium ascorbate which will prevent ascorbic acid deficiency in the body.

Before you use Fuji Vitamin C

-When you must not use it

Do not take this medicine if you have an allergy to any of the ingredients listed in this leaflet.

-Before you start to use it

Talk to you doctor before taking this medicine. Use of Fuji Vitamin C should be considered if you have:

- gout
- Inherited iron buildup disorder (Hemochromatosis) or impaired ability of the bone marrow to produce normal red blood cells (sideroblastic anaemic) or Thalassemia (inherited blood disorder).
- too much oxalate crystals in the urine.

Pregnancy and lactation

Talk to you doctor before taking this medicine if you are pregnant, might become pregnant or are breastfeeding.

-Taking other medicines

Inform your doctor or pharmacist before taking this medicines, including any that you get without a prescription from your pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

Some medicines and Fuji Vitamin C may interfere with each other. They may be affected by Fuji Vitamin C or may affect how well it works.

- It may enhances iron absorption from the gastrointestinal tract.
- It may decrease fluphenazine levels.
- Ascorbic acid and warfarin may decrease anticoagulant effect.
- It may affect oral contraceptive effect.

How to use Fuji Vitamin C

-How much to use

Always use Fuji Vitamin C exactly as your doctor has prescribed. You should check with your doctor or pharmacist if in doubt.

The usual dose:

Children: 100-400 mg daily.

Adult: 100-600 mg daily.

-When to use it

Use as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

-How long to use it

Continue taking Fuji Vitamin C as your doctor recommended. If symptoms persist, consult your doctor.

-If you forget to use it

Consult your doctor or pharmacist on what you should do if you forget to use it.

Take the missed dose as soon as you remember. If it is almost time for your next dose, wait until then to take the medicine and skip the missed dose. Do not take a double dose to make up for the missed dose.

-If you use too much (overdose)

Contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital, if you think you or anyone else may have taken too much of this medicine. Do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning. You may need urgent medical attention.

Taking large doses of Fuji Vitamin C rarely cause hazardous effects as it is a water-soluble vitamin, and therefore the excess is rapidly eliminated in the urine.

While you are using Fuji Vitamin C

-Things you must do

Tell all the doctors, dentists and pharmacists treating you that you are taking Fuji Vitamin C.

-Things you must not do

- Do not take more than the recommended dose unless your pharmacist or doctor tells you.
- Do not take any new medicines without consulting your doctor.
- Do not give Fuji Vitamin C to anyone else, even if they have the same symptoms or condition as you.

-Things to be careful of

Be careful driving or operating machinery until you know how Fuji Vitamin C affects you.

Side effects

Like all medicines, Fuji Vitamin C can cause side effects, although rarely occur when used within the prescribing limits. If side effects persist, do not take the medicine and refer to the doctor.

Tell your doctor if you notice any of the following side effects or notice any other effects not listed:

- Diarrhea
- Stomach cramps
- Dizziness
- Headache

Storage and disposal of Fuji Vitamin C

-Storage

Keep cap tightly closed. Protect from heat and light. Store in a cool dry place. Keep medicine out of reach of children.

-Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
