

HOE AQUEOUS CREAM

Emulsifying Wax (9%w/w)

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This leaflet answers some common questions about HOE AQUEOUS CREAM. It does not contain all the available information. It does not take the place of talking to your pharmacist or doctor.

All medicines have risks and benefits. Your pharmacist or doctor has weighed the risks of you taking HOE AQUEOUS CREAM against the benefits they expect it will have for you.

If you have any concerns about taking this medicine, ask your pharmacist or doctor.

Keep this leaflet with the medicine.

You may need to read it again.

What HOE AQUEOUS CREAM is used for

It may be used as an emollient and protectant for dry skin conditions.

How HOE AQUEOUS CREAM works

HOE AQUEOUS CREAM is made from a mixture of emulsifying wax and water, and is used both as an emollient to moisturise the skin.

Before you use HOE AQUEOUS CREAM

-When you must not use it

Do not use HOE AQUEOUS CREAM:

- If you are hypersensitivity to emulsifying wax or any components in this preparation.

-Before you start to take it

Tell your doctor or pharmacist:

- If you are pregnant, might become pregnant or are breast-feeding.

-Taking other medicines

Tell your pharmacist or doctor if you are taking any other products (such as over the counter product, prescribed medicine and herbal products). There is no known medicine interactions with HOE AQUEOUS CREAM have been reported.

How to use HOE AQUEOUS CREAM

Always use HOE AQUEOUS CREAM as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

-How much to use

As an emollient:

- Apply sparingly to the affected area two or three times daily.

-When to use it

Use as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

-How long to use it

If condition worsens or does not improve after regular use of this product as directed, consult a doctor.

-If you forget to use it

If you forget to use your cream at the right time, use it as soon as you remember, then carry on as before. Do not double the dose to catch up.

-If you take too much (overdose)

If, by mistake on a few occasions you use more than you should, do not worry. If you apply a lot or a lot is accidentally swallowed, it could make you ill. Talk to your doctor or go to the hospital as soon as possible.

While you are using HOE AQUEOUS CREAM

-Things you must do

If you are about to start taking on any other new medicine, tell your doctor or pharmacist that you are using HOE AQUEOUS CREAM.

-Things you must not do

Avoid contact with eyes and mucous membranes (for external use only). HOE AQUEOUS CREAM may cause skin irritation. If you are not sure, talk to your doctor or pharmacist before using.

-Things to be careful of

If irritation or sensitivity occurs, treatment should be discontinued. Advise to consult doctor if no improvement is seen.

Side effects

Like all medicines, HOE AQUEOUS CREAM can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them. As with all medicines, some people may be allergic to the cream.

If any side effect becomes severe, or you notice any side effect not listed here, please tell your doctor or pharmacist.

Storage and Disposal of HOE AQUEOUS CREAM

-Storage

Store below 30°C.
Keep container well closed.
Protect from strong light.
Keep out of reach of children.

-Disposal

Dispose the medicine after the expiry date.
Consult your pharmacist on how to safely dispose of any medicines no longer required.

Emulsifying Wax 9% w/w
