**What Dermasolve Ointment is used for**

Dermasolve Ointment is indicated for the treatment of fungal skin infections including athlete's foot (tinea pedis), jock itch (tinea cruris), ringworm (tinea corporis) and common yeast infection of skin.

**How Dermasolve Ointment works**

Dermasolve Ointment contains Tolnaftate which is used for the treatment of superficial fungal infections of skin. Its spectrum of action encompasses typical fungi responsible for various forms of skin and yeast infection.

**Before you use Dermasolve Ointment***- When you must not use it*

Do not use if you are hypersensitivity to Tolnaftate or any other ingredients in this product.

*- Before you start to use it*

Tell your doctor if you are pregnant or breast-feeding.

Not recommended for use in babies and young children under 2 years old unless advised by a doctor.

*- Taking other medicines*

No known. However care should be taken when using together with other topical medicines as other topical medicines may affect the absorption or effectiveness of Tolnaftate application.

**How to use Dermasolve Ointment***- How much to use*

Clean and dry the infected area. Apply the ointment thinly and evenly onto the infected area twice daily.

*- When to use it*

Use it when required.

*- How long to use it*

Treatment for 2 weeks. To prevent recurrence, continue treatment for another 2 weeks after symptoms disappear.

A total of 4 to 6 weeks treatment period may be necessary. Longer treatment period may be repeated if infection recurs. Longer treatment period may be required for nail infection to clear up.

*- If you forget to use it*

If you forget to use Dermasolve Ointment, use it as soon as you remember.

*- If you use too much (overdose)*

Overdose is unlikely occur. In the event of accidental ingestion, the individual should be send to the nearest hospital for medical advice.

**While you are using Dermasolve Ointment***- Things you must do*

Check with your doctor if symptoms persist or getting worse.

*- Things you must not do*

Do not use Dermasolve Ointment to treat any other conditions unless your doctor or pharmacist tells you so.

*- Things to be careful of*

Tolnaftate is generally well-tolerated. Occasionally, itching or redness may occur at the area of application. If you notice any symptom, stop use and tell your doctor or pharmacist.

**Side Effects**

Occasionally, itching or redness may occur at the area of application.

**Storage and Disposal of Dermasolve Ointment***- Storage*

- Store below 30°C.
- Protect from light.
- Keep out of reach of children.

*- Disposal*

Do not use this after the expiry date. An expiry date is printed on the label and box of the medicine.

Active ingredient  
Tolnaftate 1.0%w/w

Inactive ingredients  
Cetomacrogol Emulsifying Wax, Hard Paraffin, Cetosteary Alcohol, White Soft Paraffin, Lamellar Gel System, Polyxyl 40 Hydrogenated Castor Oil, Hydrogenated Polyisobutene, Butylated Hydroxytoluene, Isopropyl Myristate, Propylene Glycol, N-Methylpyrrolidone, Benzyl Alcohol, Menthol.
