What Prime's Calamine cream is used for

For relief of dermatitis (skin inflammation and eczema (red, itchy skin) discomfort, itchiness, dry skin, diaper rash, insect stings and bites.

How Prime's Calamine cream works

Calamine and zinc oxide have mild astringent action on the skin. It is a soothing application for the treatment of eczema and as a protective for slight skin scraping.

Before you use Prime's Calamine cream

- When you must not use it
 - allergic to its active ingredients or other ingredients of the product.
- Before you start to use it

Inform the doctor if pregnant or breast-feeding.
- Taking other medicines

The medicine is for topical application, usually will have minimal effect on other medications. However, please inform the doctor or pharmacist if taking other medicines.

How to use Prime's Calamine cream

- How much to use

Apply to the skin as required.
- When to use it

Please follow the advice of the doctor or pharmacist.

- How long to use it

You should check with your doctor or pharmacist.

- If you forget to use it

If forget to use this medicine, use it as soon as remember. Then next, use this medicine at the usual time.

- If you use too much (overdose)

If used too much Prime's Calamine cream, contact your doctor, an emergency department or a poison center immediately.

While you are using Prime's Calamine cream

- Things you must do

Check with the physician if condition does not improve or if it becomes worse. Inform doctor of medications taking.

- Things you must not do

Do not stop using medication although feeling better after a few days, until the prescribed course is finished.

- Things to be careful of

Treatment should be discontinued if severe irritation or allergy develops.

Side effects

No reported side effects caused by Prime's Calamine cream.

Storage and Disposal of Prime's Calamine cream

- Storage

Store in cool, dry place below 25°C. Protect from light. Keep out of reach of children.

- Disposal

Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required.
