# What ZORALIX ELIXIR is used for?

ZORALIX ELIXIR is an antihistamine used to treat a number of conditions:

- Allergic conditions
- Motion sickness
- Nausea & vomiting
- Hypnosis

#### How ZORALIX ELIXIR works?

ZORALIX ELIXIR contains Promethazine hydrochloride as an active ingredient.

Promethazine hydrochloride is an antihistamine which helps to reduce allergic symptoms by preventing the effects of a substance called histamine.

Histamine is produced by the body in response to foreign substances that the body is allergic to.

Ask your pharmacist or doctor if you have any questions about this medicine.

# Before you use ZORALIX ELIXIR

When you must not take it

Do not take ZORALIX ELIXIR if you are hypersensitive to:

- Any medicine containing promethazine hydrochloride
- Other anti-histamines of similar chemical of structure
- Any of the ingredients listed at the end of this leaflet.

## Before you start to use it

Take special care with ZORALIX ELIXIR:

 Do not use for children under two years of age, due to the potential for fatal respiratory depression.

Pregnancy and breast feeding:

Ask your doctor or pharmacist for advice before taking any medicine.

## Taking other medicines

Please tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking or have recently taken any other medicines, including medicines obtained without a prescription.

Some medicines and ZORALIX ELIXIR may interfere with each other. These include:

- anti-cholinergic agent, tricyclic anti-depressant, sedative or hypnotic
- other antihistamines
- alcohol

## When to use it

Take the medicine after meal.

## How long to use it

Do not exceed the recommended dosage and do not use for longer than 10 days in a row.

## If you forget to use it

Take the missed dose as soon as you remember.

If it is almost time for your next dose, skip the missed dose and take the medicine at your next regularly scheduled time.

Do not take a double dose to make up for the one you have missed.

#### If you use too much (overdose)

If you accidentally take too much of ZORALIX ELIXIR, overdosage

may vary from central nervous system depression to stimulation. Atropine like signs and symptoms such as dry mouth, fixed dilated pupils, flushing and gastrointestinal symptoms may also occur.

# While you are using ZORALIX ELIXIR

#### Things you must do

If you are about to start taking on any other new medicine, tell your pharmacist or doctor that you are taking ZORALIX ELIXIR.

# Things you must not do

Do not consume any food or beverages or carry out any activities which are restricted by doctors while taking ZORALIX ELIXIR.

# Things to be careful of

During the first days of treatment with ZORALIX ELIXIR reactions may be impaired. Do not to take charge of vehicles or machinery until the effect of ZORALIX ELIXIR treatment on the individual is known.

#### Side effects

ZORALIX ELIXIR may cause side effects. Tell your doctor if any of these symptoms are severe or do not go away.

- dry mouth
- stomach upset
- loss of appetite
- nausea or vomiting
- diarrhoea or constipation
- tiredness or sleepiness
- low blood pressure
- dizziness
- blurred vision
- muscular weakness
- in-coordination
- jaundice yellow tinge to skin or eves
- tinnitus buzzing, hissing, ringing or other persistent noise in the ears

#### irritability

If any of the side effects gets serious, or if you notice any side effects not listed in this leaflet, please tell your doctor or pharmacist.

# Storage and Disposal of ZORALIX ELIXIR

#### Storage

Store below 30°C. Keep out of the reach of children. Protect from strong light. Keep container well closed.

#### **Disposal**
