Clotrimazole 1%w/w

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What Clomazol is used for

It is used to treat fungal infections such as ringworm, athlete's foot, fungal nappy rash and fungal sweat rash, or other fungal infections of the skin.

How Clomazol works

It contains clotrimazole which is an antifungal agent which fights the cause of fungal infections.

Before you use Clomazol

When you must not use it - allergic to clotrimazole or other ingredients of *Clomazol*.

Before you start to use it
Do not apply occlusive dressing
over this medication unless
directed by doctor. Safety for use
in pregnancy and during
breastfeeding has not been
established. Inform your doctor if
you are pregnant or breastfeeding.

Taking other medicines
The medicine is for topical
application and will usually have
minimal effect on other
medications. However, please
inform the doctor or pharmacist if
taking other medicines.

How to use Clomazol

How much to use

Apply 2-3 times daily on affected area. Continue for another 2 weeks after symptoms disappear.

When to use it

Please follow the advice of the doctor or pharmacist.

How long to use it

You should check with your doctor or pharmacist.

If you forget to use it

If you forget to use this medicine, use it as soon as you remember. Then continue using it at your usual time.

If you use too much (overdose)
If you have used too much Clomazol, contact your doctor, an emergency department or a poisoning center immediately.

While you are using Clomazol

Things you must do
Inform your doctor of all the
medications you are taking.

Things you must not do

Do not stop using medication although
you feel better after a few days, until the
prescribed course is finished.

Things to be careful of

If you are pregnant, become pregnant, or are breastfeeding, you should not use *Clomazol* unless advised by your doctor.

Side effects

When applied topically, local reactions including redness, hives, itching, stinging and irritation may occur in patients. If any of the side effects become serious or any other side effects not listed in this leaflet, please inform the doctor or pharmacist.

Storage

Store in cool, dry place below 30°C. Protect from light. Keep out of reach of children. *Disposal*
