Tolnaftate / Chlorhexidine Acetate (1.00% w/w / 0.20% w/w)

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What Cosmos Fungil Cream is used for

Cosmos Fungil Cream is used to relief and treat athlete's foot, ringworm, fungal infection of the groin area and fungal infection of the skin.

Ask your doctor if you have any questions about why this medicine has been prescribed for you. Your doctor may have prescribed this medicine for another reason.

How Cosmos Fungil Cream works

Cosmos Fungil Cream contains tolnaftate and chlorhexidine acetate as active ingredients. Tolnaftate belongs to the group of medicine called antifungal. Chlorhexidine acetate is an antibacterial agent.

Before you use Cosmos Fungil Cream

When you must not take it

Do not use Cosmos Fungil Cream if you are allergic to tolnaftate, chlorhexidine acetate or any of the ingredients listed at the end of this leaflet. Do not use this medicine after the expiry date printed on the pack or if the packaging is torn or shows signs of tampering.

If it has expired or is damaged, return it to your pharmacist for disposal.

If you are not sure whether you should start using this medicine, talk to your doctor.

- Before you start to use it

Tell your doctor if you have allergies to any other medicines, foods, preservatives or dyes.

- Taking other medicines

Tell your doctor if you are taking any other medicines, including medicines that you buy without a prescription from your pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

Some medicines may interact with Cosmos Fungil Cream. However, no specific interactions with Cosmos Fungil Cream are known at this time.

Your doctor or pharmacist has more information on medicines to be careful with or avoid while using Cosmos Fungil Cream.

How to use Cosmos Fungil Cream

- How much to use

Athlete's foot, ringworm and fungal infection of the groin area

Apply on the affected area two times a day, morning and evening.

Fungal infection of the skin Apply once a day. Gently massage cream onto the affected area.

- When to use it

Use Cosmos Fungil Cream as your doctor has prescribed.

- How long to use it

Continue using your medicine for as long as your doctor tells you.

For fungal infection of skin, continue using the cream for 2 to 3 weeks, prolong treatment for 10 days to prevent relapse.

Check with your doctor if no improvement within 4 weeks for fungal infection of the groin area.

- If you forget to use it

If you forget to apply the medicine, you can apply it as soon as you remember.

- <u>If you use too much</u> (overdose)

Contact your doctor immediately or go to the nearest hospital Emergency Department, if you are overdose. This should be done although there is no poisoning or discomfort. You may need immediate medical attention.

While you are using it

- Things you must do

Always follow your doctor's instructions carefully.

- Things you must not do

Do not use if irritation occurs with Cosmos Fungil Cream.

Do not give Cosmos Fungil Cream to anyone else, even if they have the same condition as you.

Do not use Cosmos Fungil Cream to treat any other complaints unless your doctor tells you to.

Cosmos Fungil Cream contains chlorhexidine. Inform your healthcare provider if you have a known allergy to chlorhexidine.

Stop using this product and seek immediate medical assistance if you experience rash, itching, swelling, breathing difficulties, lightheadedness or rapid heartbeat.

- Things to be careful of

Avoid contact with the eyes and mucous membrane.

Be sure to use Cosmos Fungil Cream for the full course of treatment. If you do not, the medicine may not clear up the infection completely.

Side effects

All medicines can have side effects. Sometimes they are serious, most of the time they are not.

Ask for the advice of your doctor or pharmacist if you have any concerns about the effects of using this medicine. Rarely, it causes skin irritation.

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you notice anything else that is making you feel unwell.

Storage and Disposal of Cosmos Fungil Cream

- Storage

Keep the medicine in a dry place.

Do not store Cosmos Fungil Cream or any other medicine in the bathroom or near a sink.

Do not leave it in the car or on window sills.

Heat and dampness can destroy some medicines.

Keep Cosmos Fungil Cream where children cannot reach it.

A locked cupboard at least one-and-a-half metres above the ground is a good place to store medicines.

- <u>Disposal</u>

Ask your pharmacist what to do with any medicine you have left over if your doctor tells you to stop using them, or you find that the expiry date has passed.
