What Lycort N Skin Cream is used for

Lycort N Skin Cream is used to treat all inflammatory diseases of the skin such as eczema, dermatitis, seborrhea (excessively oily skin) and intertrigo (inflammatory condition of skin folds), when bacterial infection is present.

How Lycort N Skin Cream works

Lycort N Skin Cream contains a medicine called Fluocinolone Acetonide. It belongs to a group of medicines called corticosteroids. It has anti-inflammatory, anti-itching and blood vessel narrowing actions whereas Neomycin Sulphate is an antibiotic, which is active against many types of bacteria.

Before you use Lycort N Skin Cream

- When you must not use it

Do not take Lycort N Skin Cream if:

- You are allergic (hypersensitive) to neomycin.
- You have history of hypersensitivity to topical corticosteroids or to any of the components of the preparation.
- You have infection of the skin caused by bacteria or fungi or viruses and in rosacea, acne perioral dermatitis (acne around the mouth), anogenital pruritus (intense itching around the genital) and napkin rash.

- Before you start use it

The local application of Lycort N Skin Cream on skin with extensive damage or rupture of the eardrum may result in deafness. Prolonged local use should be avoided as it may lead to skin sensitivity.

Pregnancy and lactation

Ask your doctor or pharmacist for advice before taking this medicine if you are pregnant or breast-feeding

- Taking other medicines

Tell your pharmacist or doctor if you are taking any other products (such as over the counter drug, prescribed drug and herbal products)

How to use Lycort N Skin Cream

Always use Lycort N Skin Cream exactly as your doctor or pharmacist has told you.

- How much to use

Adults:

Apply a small quantity of Lycort N Skin Cream to the affected area and massaged gently and thoroughly to the skin 2 or 3 times daily as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

If you require occlusive dressing, the affected area should be thoroughly cleaned first before applying Lycort N Skin Cream.

- When to use it

Always use Lycort N Skin Cream exactly as your doctor has instructed you. You should check with your doctor or pharmacist if you are unsure.

- How long to use it

You should check with your doctor or pharmacist.

- If you forget to use it

If you forget to use your cream at the right time, use it as soon as you remember, then carry on as before. Do not double the dose to catch up.

- If you use too much (overdose)

Toxic effects are not likely to occur following accidental ingestion of the contents of the tube. If you ingested a greater quantity and toxicity develops, please consult your doctor immediately.

While you are using it

- Things you must do

If you are about to start taking on any other new medicine, tell your pharmacist or doctor that you are taking Lycort N Skin Cream.

- Things you must not do

Do not take more than the recommended dose unless your doctor tells you to.

Do not apply into the eyes.

- Things to be careful of

Discontinue use if irritation or sensitivity reaction develops.

Side effects

Like all medicines, Lycort N Skin Cream can cause side effects although not everybody gets them. Tell your doctor immediately if you experience any of the following symptoms after taking this medicine as the symptoms can be severe.

- Irritation at the site of application
- Hypersensitivity reactions
- Stretch marks
- Skin thinning
- Dilation of blood vessels
- Gradual loss of muscle
- Another infection that occurs during or after treatment for the initial infection

Storage and Disposal of Lycort N Skin Cream

- Storage

Store below 25°C in a cool, dry place protect from moisture and excessive heat.

- Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.

Fluocinolone Acetonide 0.025% w/w and Neomycin 0.5% w/w

- Inactive ingredients

Cetomacrogol 1000, Cetostearyl Alcohol, White Soft Paraffin, Light Liquid Paraffin, Propylene Glycol, Propyl Paraben, Methyl Paraben, Sodium Phosphate Monobasic and Purified water.
