What Cera-Scalp Ointment is used for

Cera-Scalp Ointment is for the treatment of common scaly skin disorders of the scalp such as psoriasis, seborrhoeic dermatitis, dandruff and eczema.

How Cera-Scalp Ointment works

Cera-Scalp Oinment works by reducing the scaliness skin disorders. Coal tar solution and sulfur reduces inflammation of the skin and salicylic acid helps remove scale.

Ask your pharmacist or doctor if you have any questions about this medicine.

Before you use Cera-Scalp Ointment

-When you must not use it Do not take Cera-Scalp Ointment if:

Hypersensitive to any of the ingredients

Do not use if any of the above apply to you. If you are not sure, talk to your doctor or pharmacist.

Pregnancy and breast feeding:

Ask your doctor or pharmacist for advice before taking this medicine if you are pregnant or breast-feeding.

-Taking other medicines

Tell your doctor if you are taking any other medicines, including any that you buy without a prescription from a pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

How to use Cera-Scalp Ointment Using this medicine

- Part the hair and apply a thin ribbon of Cera-Scalp Ointment to the affected area of the scalp. Gently rub in the ointment and leave in contact with the scalp for approximately one hour.
 Wash the hands immediately.
- Remove Cera-Scalp
 Ointment after one hour from
 the scalp by rinsing with
 warm water and shampoo.
- Take care to avoid getting the application in the eyes.
 Always wash hands immediately after use.

-How much to use

For treatment of mild dandruff: To be applied once a week

For treatment of psoriasis, eczema, seborrheic dermatitis and severe dandruff:

Apply daily for three to seven days until improvement has been achieved. Intermittent repeated applications may be necessary to maintain improvement.

-How long to use it

Consult with your doctor if your symptoms do not improve after four week of treatment.

-If you forget to use it

If you forget to use your cream at the right time, use it as soon as you remember, then carry on as before.

Do not take double dose to make up for the forgotten dose.

-If you use too much (overdose)
Contact your doctor immediately
or go to the Emergency
Department of your nearest
hospital, if you think you or
anyone else may have taken too
much of this medicine. Do this
even if there are no signs of
discomfort or poisoning. You may

need urgent medical attention.

-Things you must do

Take your medicine exactly as your doctor has told you.

Tell all the doctors, dentists and pharmacists treating you that you are taking Cera-Scalp Ointment. Discontinue use if irritation develops.

Tell your doctor immediately if you become pregnant while taking this medication.

-Things you must not do Do not stop taking the medicine

unless advised by your doctor.

Do not take any new medicines without consulting your doctor or pharmacist.

Do not give Cera-Scalp Ointment to anyone else, even if they have the same symptoms or condition as you.

-Things to be careful of For external used only.

Side effects

Cera-Scalp may cause side effects. These include:

- Irritation of the skin
- Inflammation of the hair follicles
- Rarely hypersensitivity to sunlight.

Storage and Disposal of Cera-Scalp Ointment

-Storage

Store below 30°C. Keep in a cool dry place, protected from light. Keep out of reach of children.

Do not take the medicine after the expiry date on the label.

-Disposal

Dispose the medicine after the expiry date.

Consult your pharmacist on how to safely dispose of any medicines no longer required.

Cera-Scalp Ointment is a smooth khaki, unctuous mass with distinctive odour of coal tar.

Cera-Scalp Ointment is available in tubes containing 40g.

-Ingredients

-Active ingredient(s): Each 40g contains Coal Tar Solution 12% w/w, Salicylic Acid 2% w/w and Sulphur 4% w/w.

-Inactive ingredients: Coconut oil, White soft paraffin, Glycerol, Cetostearyl alcohol, Liquid paraffin, Polyoxethylene glycerol monostearate, Hard paraffin.
