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What Fuji Multivit is used for

As a food supplement for children.

How Fuji Multivit works

Fuji Multivit contains nine active ingredients, which are Nicotinamide (B3), Pyridoxine Hydrochloride (B6). Ascorbic Acid, Cyanocobalamin (B12), Vitamin A, Vitamin E, Vitamin D3, (B2) and Thiamine Riboflavine Hydrochloride (B1). These are the vitamins which will prevent vitamin deficiencies in the body.

Before vou use Fuji Multivit

-When you must not use it

Do not take this medicine if you have an allergy to any of the ingredients listed in this leaflet.

-Before you start to use it

Talk to you doctor before taking this medicine.

-Taking other medicines

Inform your doctor or pharmacist before taking this medicines, including any that you get without a prescription from your pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

How to use Fuji Multivit

-How much to use

Always use Fuji Multivit exactly as your doctor has prescribed. You should check with your doctor or pharmacist if in doubt.

The usual dose:

Children:

2-6 years: 1 tab daily. 6-12 years: 1-2 tab daily. Or as directed by physician.

-When to use it

Use as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

-How long to use it

Continue taking Fuji Multivit as your doctor recommended. If symptoms persist, consult your doctor.

-If you forget to use it

Consult your doctor or pharmacist on what you should do if you forget to use

Take the missed dose as soon as you remember. If it is almost time for your next dose, wait until then to take the medicine and skip the missed dose. Do not take a double dose to make up for the missed dose.

-If you use too much (overdose)

Contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital, if you think you or anyone else may have taken too much of this medicine. Do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning. You may need urgent medical attention.

Taking too much Fuji Multivit may

- Vitamin A- fatigue, irritability, loss of appetite, loss of weight, vomiting, gastrointestinal disturbances, fever, excessive urination, bleeding lips, dry skin.
- Vitamin D- loss of appetite, lassitude, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, loss of weight, excessive urination, profuse sweating, headache, extreme tiredness, spinning sensation, increase calcium blood level.
- Vitamin E- Fatigue, weakness, nausea, headache, blurred vision, flatulence, diarrhea.

Toxicity reversed by withdrawal of these vitamins and it is rarely occur in vitamin group B & C as they are water soluble.

While you are using Fuji Multivit

-Things you must do

Tell all the doctors, dentists and pharmacists treating you that you are taking Fuji Multivit.

-Things you must not do

- Do not take more than the recommended dose unless your pharmacist or doctor tells you.
- Do not take any new medicines without consulting your doctor or pharmacist.
- Do not give Fuji Multivit to anyone else, even if they have the same symptoms or condition as you.

-Things to be careful of

Keep medicine out of reach for children.

Side effects

Like all medicines, Fuji Multivit can cause side effects, although rarely occur when used within the prescribing limits. If side effects persist, do not take the medicine and refer to the doctor.

Storage and disposal of Fuji Multivit

-Storage

Store in cool & dry place. Keep cap tightly closed. Protect from light.

-Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.

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-Inactive ingredients Spirit Chloroform, Tutti Frutti, Aspartame, National starch, Mannitol, Magnesium Stearate, Kollidon PVP and Microcrystalline Cellulose.
