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What Creobic Cream is used for

Creobic Cream is an imidazole antifungal agent.

How Creobic Cream works

Creobic Cream is used topically in the management of all fungal skin infections due to dermatophytes, yeasts, moulds and other fungi. These include ringworm (tinea) infections, athlete's foot, paronychia (inflammation of the tissue surrounding fingernail or toenail), pityriasis versicolour (fungal infection), erythrasma (skin disease). intertrigo (inflammatory condition of skin folds), fungal nappy rash, candida vulvitis (vaginal infection) and candida balanitis (penis head infection).

Before you use Creobic Cream

-When you must not use it

Do not use Creobic Cream if:

- It is not prescribed by a qualified doctor or pharmacist for you.
- Treatment should be stopped if signs of hypersensitivity appears.

-Before you start to use it

Tell your doctor if:

- You are allergic to any medicines.
- You are taking or using any other medicines (including those not prescribed by your doctor).

-Taking other medicines

You should tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking any others medicines currently.

It may still be all right for you to use Creobic Cream and your doctor will be able to decide what is suitable for you.

How to use Creobic Cream

How much to use

This cream is for external use only.

- Apply thinly and evenly to the affected area 2 to 3 times daily, and rubbed gently.
- If the feet are infected, they should be thoroughly washed and dried, especially between the toes, before applying the cream.
- Consult doctors if no improvement in 4 weeks (for athlete's foot) or 2 weeks (for jock itch).

-When to use it

Your doctor will decide when it is appropriate for you to use Creobic Cream according to the type of condition you have.

-How long to use it

- Use this cream as stated in this leaflet without skipping or exceeding the frequency of application in a day and overall duration of application.
- Usually a treatment should be continued for at least one month or for at least 2 weeks after the disappearance of all signs of infection to prevent relapse.
- Follow any recommendations and advises from your doctor or pharmacist on how long you need to take your medicine.

-If you forget to use it

If you forget to use your cream at a certain time, use your cream immediately. However, if it is nearly time for your next application, skip the missed application.

-If you use too much (overdose)

If, by mistake on a few occasions you use more than you should, do not worry. If you apply a lot or a lot is accidentally swallowed, it could make you ill. Talk to your doctor or go to the hospital as soon as possible

While You Are Using It

-Things you must do

- Discuss with your doctor or pharmacist the dos' and don'ts' while taking this medicine.
- Tell your doctor if unexpectedly you need to take any other medicines.
- Take the Creobic Cream according to the recommended dosage.
- Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you experience any side effects that are not listed in this leaflet.

-Things you must not do

- Do not use your Creobic Cream more than the suggested frequency in a day.
- Do not apply multiple layers to the affected area.

-Things to be careful of

- Avoid contact with eyes, ears or mucous membranes.
- Do not use on children below 2 years old except under the advice and supervision of a doctor.

Side Effects

Like all medicines, Creobic Cream can cause side effects although not everybody gets them. You are advised to consult doctor/ pharmacist for further information. The following side effects have been reported:

- Local irritation.
- Mild burning sensation.

Storage and disposal of Creobic Cream

Keep Creobic Cream out of reach of children.

Store below 30°C. Keep container well closed and protect from light.

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-Disposal

Do not use Creobic Cream after the expiry date which is stated on the carton.

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
