What Dyna Cough Syrup is used for

Indicated for the relief symptoms of cough.

How Dyna Cough Syrup works

Guaiphenesin is a substance that helps loosen and liquefy mucus. It works by thinning the mucus and lubricates the airway, facilitating the removal of cold, flu and allergy-associated mucus from the chest by coughing, and making it easier to breathe.

Before you use Dyna Cough Syrup

- When you must not use it
Pregnancy and lactation

Dyna Cough Syrup can be used if the benefits outweigh the risks.

Ask your doctor or pharmacists for advice before taking Dyna Cough Syrup.

- Before you start to use it

Tell your doctor if you have hypersensitivity to Guaiphenesin and other ingredients listed in the leaflet.

- Taking other medicines

Tell your doctor if you are taking any other medicines, including any that you buy without a prescription from a pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

How to use Dyna Cough Syrup

- How much to use

Children below 2 years old: Dosage must be individualized by a physician
Children 2 to 6 years: ¼ to ½ teaspoonful (1.25 ml to 2.5 ml) 4 hourly not exceeding (15 ml) per day
Children 6 to 12 years: ½ to 1 teaspoonful (2.5 ml to 5 ml) 4 hourly not exceeding (30 ml) per day

Adults: 1 to 2 teaspoonfuls (5 ml to 10 ml) 4 hourly not exceeding (60 ml) per day.

The directions given may differ from the information contained in this leaflet. If you do not understand the instructions on the label, ask your doctor or pharmacist for help.

- When to use it

Use as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.

- How long to use it

Continue taking Dyna Cough Syrup for as long as your doctor recommends.

- If you forget to use it

Take the missed dose as soon as you remember. If it almost time for your next dose, wait until then to take the medicine and skip the missed dose. Do not take a double dose to make up for the missed dose.

- If you use too much (overdose)

Overdosage may cause adverse reactions such as nausea, vomiting, dizziness, headache or rashes.

Contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital, if you think you or anyone else may have taken too much of this medicine. Do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning. You may need urgent medical attention.

While you are using it

- Things you must do

Take your medicine exactly as your doctor has told you.

Tell the doctor, dentist and pharmacist treating you that you are taking Dyna Cough Syrup.

- Things you must not do

Do not take any new medicines without consulting your doctor or pharmacist.

Do not give Dyna Cough Syrup to anyone else, even if they have the same symptoms or condition as you.

- Things to be careful of

This product is unsuitable for people with phenylketonuria (metabolic disorder).

Side effects

Side effects of the Dyna Cough Syrup usually nausea, stomach and intestinal discomfort, drowsiness, thirst, headache, rapid breathing and low blood potassium.

Visit your doctor or pharmacist immediately if you experience any side effects after taking this medicine. Storage and Disposal of Dyna Cough Syrup

- Storage

Keep out of reach of children
Protect from light
Store in dry place below 30°C
Keep the container tightly closed
Shake well before use

- Disposal

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
