What Ketozol is used for

For the treatment and prevention of white spots, oily inflammatory skin and dandruff.

How Ketozol works

It is an antifungal, which works by killing the fungus that causes the infections.

Before you use Ketozol

When you must not use it

- allergic to the ingredients of the product.

Before you start to use it

Compliance with full course of therapy, fungal infection may require prolonged treatment.

Taking other medicines

The medicine is for topical application, usually will have minimal effect on other medications. However, please inform the doctor or pharmacist if taking other medicines.

How to use Ketozol

- How much to use

The affected areas of the skin or the hair should be washed with shampoo, which should be left on the skin for 3 – 5 minutes before rinsing. Oily inflammatory skin or dandruff - twice weekly for 2 – 4 weeks, prevention - once every 1 – 2 weeks. White spots - once daily for 5 days, prevention - once daily for 3 days for a single treatment course.

- When to use it

Please follow the advice of the doctor or pharmacist.

- How long to use it

You should check with your doctor or pharmacist.

- If you forget to use it

If forget to use this medicine, use it as soon as remember. Then next, use this medicine at the usual time.

- If you use too much (overdose)

If used too much Ketozol, contact your doctor, an emergency department or a poison center immediately.

While you are using Ketozol

- Things you must do

Inform doctor of medications taking.

- Things you must not do

Do not stop using medication although feeling better after a few days, until the prescribed course is finished. Avoid shampoo to the eyes.

- Things to be careful of

If pregnant or become pregnant or breast-feeding during treatment, should not use Ketozol unless doctor advised.

Side effects

Irritation, inflammation of the skin or a burning sensation may occur. In rare instances, mainly in patients with chemically damaged hair or grey hair, a discoloration of the hair has been observed. If any of the side effects become serious or any other side effects not listed in this leaflet, please inform the doctor or pharmacist.

Storage and Disposal of Ketozol

- Storage

Store in cool, dry place below 30°C. Protect from light. Keep out of reach of children.

- Disposal

Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required.

- Inactive ingredients: sodium lauryl ethyl sulphate, cocamidopropylbetaine, lanolin, sodium chloride, methyl parabens, propyl parabens, allura red, fragrance, citric acid and purified water.
