

AXOL LIQUID

Ambroxol Hydrochloride (3mg/ml)

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What AXOL LIQUID is used for

AXOL LIQUID is a medicine used in the treatment of respiratory disorders associated with viscid mucus.

How AXOL LIQUID works

AXOL LIQUID contains ambroxol, which helps to dissolve thick mucus and improve the condition of difficulty in expectoration, coughing and difficulty in breathing.

Before you use AXOL LIQUID

- When you must not use it
If you are allergic towards ambroxol hydrochloride or any other ingredients listed in this product.
- Before you start to use it
Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are allergic to any other medicines or you have any other health-related problems.
- Taking other medicines
Seek for your doctor or pharmacist advice if you intend to use AXOL LIQUID together with other medication. You must also inform them about all the medicines you are taking, including those without a prescription.

How to use AXOL LIQUID

- How much to use
Adult and children over 10 years old: 10ml (2 teaspoons).
Children, 5-10 years old: 5ml (1 teaspoon).
2-5 years old: 2.5ml (1/2 teaspoon).
Under 2 years old: 2.5ml (1/2 teaspoon).

- When to use it
Take AXOL LIQUID 2 to 3 times a day or as directed by your doctor or pharmacist. It can be taken with or without food.
- How long to use it
AXOL LIQUID should be taken as your doctor advised you to do so.
- If you forget to use it
If you miss a dose of AXOL LIQUID, take it as soon as possible. If it is approaching time for the next dose, do not double the dose to make up for the forgotten dose.
- If you use too much (overdose)
Contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital, if you think you or anyone else may have taken too much of this medicine. Do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning. You may need urgent medical attention.

While you are using it

- Things you must do
Follow your doctor's instruction when you are taking AXOL LIQUID.
- Things you must not do
Do not stop taking this medicine or change the dosing regimen without instruction from your doctor. Do not give AXOL LIQUID to anyone else, even if they have the same condition as you.
- Things to be careful of
The benefits of the medicine in pregnant women during first trimester should be weighed against a possible risk to the fetus. Consult your doctor or pharmacist if you are pregnant or breastfeeding.

Side effects

Abdominal pain, stomach pain, diarrhea, nausea, vomiting, constipation and indigestion. Other side effects such as skin rash, itchiness and redness have also been reported.

AXOL LIQUID may cause severe allergy and serious skin reactions. Stop using

AXOL LIQUID and seek medical assistance immediately if you experience any of the following symptoms:

- 1) Severe allergy: breathing difficulties, light headedness, skin swellings or rash.
- 2) Severe skin reaction: skin reddening, blisters, rash, fever, sore throat or eye irritation.

Storage and Disposal of AXOL LIQUID

- Storage
Keep in a tight container. Store below 30°C, protect from light & moisture.
- Disposal
AXOL LIQUID should be disposed when your doctor or pharmacist tells you to stop taking this tablet or it has passed the expiry date. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose medicines that are no longer required.
