What Sensitive Teeth Mouthwash is used for

It is used to reduce the discomfort and pain of sensitive teeth to tooth brushing, sweets, hot, cold, or acidic food and beverages.

How Sensitive Teeth Mouthwash works

It contains two active ingredients. Potassium Nitrate is clinically proven to prevent and reduce the discomfort and pain of sensitive teeth by directly calming the nerve endings inside the pulp of the teeth. Sodium Fluoride helps strengthen tooth enamel and prevent tooth decay.

Before you use Sensitive Teeth Mouthwash

- When you must not use it

Do not use it if you ever had an allergic reaction to potassium nitrate, sodium fluoride or any of the excipients in the formulation.

- Before you start to use it

If you have been told by your health care provider of any intolerances, contact and check with the healthcare provider before using.

- Taking other medicines

Ask your health care provider if potassium nitrate/sodium fluoride may interact with other medicines that you take. No specific interactions are known at this time.

How to use Sensitive Teeth Mouthwash

- How much to use

Fill cap to 20ml line

- When to use it

Use twice a day or as prescribed by your dentist.

- How long to use it

Hold and swish around the mouth gently with 20ml of undiluted mouthwash for 30 seconds or when pain occurs.

- If you forget to use it

If you miss a dose, use it as soon as possible and go back to your regular dosing schedule.

- If you use too much (overdose)

If symptoms occur and become worse, check with your doctor or seek medical attention.

While you are using it

- Things you must do

For oral use only. Do not swallow. Keep out of reach of children. Ensure liquid contacts the surface of the affected teeth.

- Things you must not do

Keep out of the eyes. Wash promptly and thoroughly with water if the solution comes into contact with the eyes.

- Things to be careful of

If symptoms do not get better or if they get worse, check with your dentist as soon as possible for any other underlying problem that may cause sensitive teeth.

Side effects

Mouth or gum irritation may rarely occur. If this effect persists or worsens, contact your doctor/dentist or pharmacist promptly.
