- When you must not use it

- Taking other medicines

Currently there have been no reports of problems when this product is used with other medicines.

How to use Egozite Baby Cream

- How much to use

Apply generous amounts to affected areas.

- When to use it

Apply to affected area at each nappy change.

- How long to use it

Please follow the advice of the doctor or pharmacist.

- If you forget to use it

If forget to use this medicine, use it as soon as remember. Then next, use this medicine at the usual time.

- *If you use too much (overdose)* Not applicable (topical preparation).

While you are using it

- Things you must do

Avoid contact with eves

Avoid contact with eyes. If irritation occurs, wash affected area and discontinue use.

- Things you must not do

Do not use soap as it may irritate.

<u>Things to be careful of</u>
If there is no improvement, consult your healthcare professional.

Side effects

Although occasional cases of hydroxybenzoate-sensitivity do occur, the level of sensitisation is low compared to the extensive use of these preservatives.
