What Axcel B-Complex Tablets is used for

Axcel B-Complex Tablets is used for prevention and treatment of Vitamin B complex deficiency.

How Axcel B-Complex Tablets works

Axcel B-Complex Tablet comprises a group of water-soluble factors closely associated in their natural occurrence. They form coenzymes essential for the metabolism of the proteins, carbohydrates or fatty acid.

Before you use Axcel B-Complex Tablets

- When you must not use it

Do not take Axcel B-Complex Tablets if:

- You are allergy or hypersensitive to ingredients in the product.
- It is not prescribed by a qualified doctor or pharmacist for you.

- Before you start to use it

Tell your doctor if:

- You are pregnant and breastfeeding.
- You are taking any other medicines (including those not prescribed by your doctor).

- Taking other medicines

Tell your doctor if you are taking any other medicines, including any that you buy without a prescription from a pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

It may still be all right for you to use Axcel B-Complex Tablets and your doctor will be able to decide what is suitable for you.

How to use Axcel B-Complex Tablets

- How much to use

To be administered orally.

Prophylactic dose is 1 tablet daily. The therapeutic dosage is 2-3 times larger or as directed by a doctor/pharmacist.

- When to use it

Your doctor will decide when it is appropriate for you to use Axcel B-Complex Tablets according to the type of condition you have.

- How long to use it

Continue taking Axcel B-Complex Tablets for as long as doctor recommends.

- If you forget to use it

Consult your doctor or pharmacist on what you should do if you forget to use it.

Take the missed dose as soon as you remember. If it is almost time for your next dose, wait until then to take the medicine and skip the missed dose. Do not take a double dose to make up for the missed dose.

- <u>If you use too much (overdose)</u>

 It is advisable for you to contact your doctor immediately or go to the Emergency Department of your nearest hospital if you did take Axcel B-Complex Tablet too much.

While you are using it

- Things you must do
- Take your medicine exactly as your doctor has told you.
- Tell all the doctors, dentists and pharmacists treating you that you are taking Axcel B-Complex Tablets.

 Tell your doctor immediately if you become pregnant while talking this medication.

- Things you must not do

- Do not stop taking the medicine unless advised by your doctor.
- Do not take any new medicines without consulting your doctor.
- Do not give Axcel B-Complex Tablets to anyone else, even if they have the same symptoms or condition as you.

- Things to be careful of

• Avoid prolonged treatment with high dosage.

Side effects

The vitamin B complex is essentially free from side-effects when administered orally. You are advised to consult doctor/pharmacist for further information.

Storage and disposal of Axcel B-Complex Tablets

- <u>Storage</u>

Keep Axcel B-Complex Tablets out of reach of children.

Store below 30°C. Keep container well closed and protect from light.

- <u>Disposal</u>

Do not use Axcel B-Complex Tablets after the expiry date which is stated on the carton.

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.
