#### What Cetrix is used for

It is used for treatment of wounds, burns, and other minor skin injuries.

#### **How Cetrix works**

Cetrimide is a relatively non-toxic antiseptic. It is active against certain microorganisms.

#### Before you use Cetrix

- When you must not use it
- allergic to cetrimide or other ingredients in the product.
- Before you start to use it

Avoid contact with the eyes. It should not be used in body cavities.

## - <u>Taking other medicines</u>

The medicine is for topical application and will usually have minimal effect on other medication. However, please inform the doctor or pharmacist if taking other medicines.

#### **How to use Cetrix**

- How much to use

Apply to the affected area as required, or as directed by the doctor.

- When to use it

Please follow the advice of the doctor or pharmacist.

- How long to use it

You should check with your doctor or pharmacist.

- If you forget to use it

If you forget to use this medicine, use it as soon as you remember. Then continue using it at your usual time.

- <u>If you use too much (overdose)</u>

If you have used too much Cetrix, contact your doctor, an emergency department or a poison center immediately.

## While you are using Cetrix

- Things you must do

Inform your doctor of all the medications you are taking.

- Things you must not do

Do not stop using medication although you feel better after a few days, until the prescribed course is finished.

- Things to be careful of

If you are pregnant, become pregnant, or breastfeeding, please inform the doctor or pharmacist.

#### Side effects

Cetrimide does not generally cause irritation, but some users may become hypersensitive to cetrimide after repeated use.

## Storage and Disposal of Cetrix

- Storage

Store in a dry place below 30°C. Protect from light. Keep out of reach of children.

- <u>Disposal</u>

Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required.
