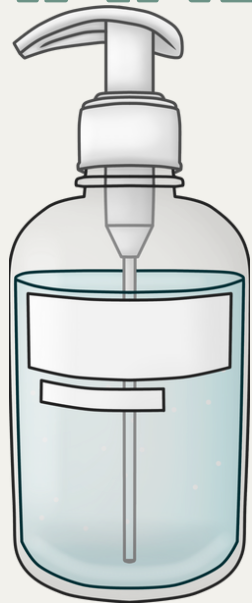

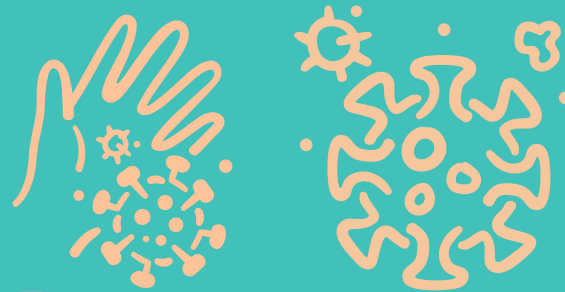

used to clean hands as it only
acts by killing germs on the skin
to reduce the spreading of
germs.



Consumers are
encouraged to use
hand sanitizers that
contain at least 60%
alcohol.

For dirty or greasy hands,
wash with soap and water
instead.



Consumers are advised to only
use hand sanitizers when soap
and water is not available.

Handwashing with soap and with
the correct technique for at least
20 seconds is an effective way to
maintain good hygiene as it helps
to remove dirt and germs

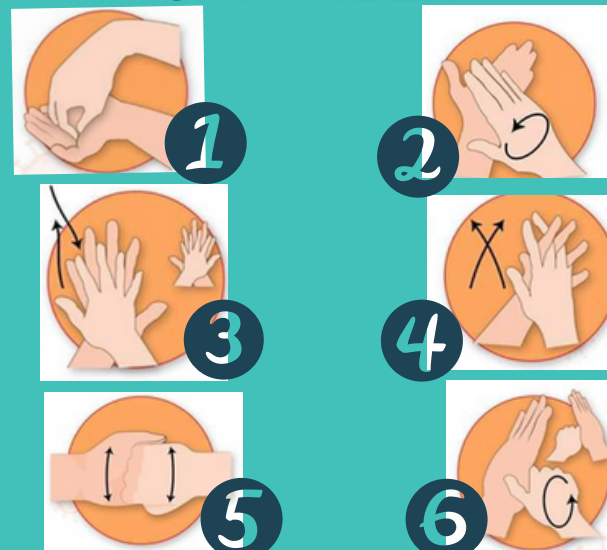
After coming into contact with soil, grease and dirt

HOW TO USE HAND SANITIZER



DO'S & DONT'S

✓ Do's

- If you get hand sanitizer in your eyes, rinse your eyes thoroughly with water as soon as possible.
- Store hand sanitizers in a dry and safe place.
- For alcohol based hand sanitizer, please avoid storing in the car.

⊘ Don'ts

- Do not wipe off or rinse the hand sanitizer before it's dry as it may not work in killing the germs.
- Alcohol-based hand sanitizer should not be used to clean surfaces. Alcohol-based hand sanitizer is not designed to clean or disinfect surfaces.
